CHARDONNAY

As the second-most planted winegrape varietal in the Lodi region, farmers have perfected the craft of growing Chardonnay winegrapes. The most common flavor profile of Lodi Appellation Chardonnay is distinct apple and tropical notes.

ZINFANDEL

Dating back to the 1800s, Zinfandel has been a part of Lodi's history for centuries. As the self-proclaimed Zinfandel capital of the world, Lodi produces over 40% of California's premium Zinfandel winegrapes.

RED BLEND

Cabernet Sauvignon, Malbec and Petit Verdot are three Bordeaux varietals that thrive in the Lodi Appellation. They do well with the various soil types and microclimates that Lodi offers, giving distinct flavors to the finished wines.
