Sand Point is a special place in Acampo, California where members of our family have enjoyed spending time and appreciating the beauty of nature. In the midst of our vineyards lies a river basin with surrounding native plants and animals. Our family has upheld the landscape to ensure future generations can have their own joyful times alongside nature. Our devotion to Sand Point is the same dedication we have for winegrape growing.

Our family has been farming the land surrounding Sand Point since the late 1940's - following the end of World War II. This was long before the region was designated an American Viticultural Area, which happened in 1986.

The sustainably certified vineyards we use to craft Sand Point wines are only a few short miles from the ranch where Sand Point lies, in the heart of the Lodi Appellation. The classic Mediterranean climate and its sandy soil provide the perfect conditions for quality wines. - The LangeTwins Family

TASTING NOTE

Our 2014 vintage is a combination of two styles of Chardonnay: the first, 100% stainless steel fermented Chardonnay to highlight the bright, crisp apple notes. The second, Chardonnay with ten months of French and American oak aging. This leads to a balance between the bright tropical fruit aromas and the rich, toasty vanilla oak flavors. Overall, it is a straightforward wine with vibrancy and richness.
