The sustainably certified Merlot vineyard is west of Sand Point in the Clarksburg Appellation. The profound maritime influence of the Sacramento Delta provides the perfect conditions for quality wines. - The LangeTwins Family

TASTING NOTE

Our 2016 Cabernet Sauvignon is full bodied, yet smooth and mellow with richness and depth. The aroma and flavors are a pleasing blend of ripe raspberries and fresh dark cherries. A juicy mouthfeel balanced by soft spice notes from oak aging complete the wine.
